Legal age to Consume Alcohol: 21

Legal age to Pour Alcohol: 19

Legal age to Sell Alcohol: 19

Legal age to Serve Alcohol: 19

Limit for Driving While Intoxicated: .08, Under 21: .02

Dram Shop Liability Laws: Yes

Maximum Alcohol per Drink: Not regulated

Number of Drinks Served at One Time: Local ordinances may apply here.

6:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m., 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. in some counties

Server Training

The state does not mandate any sort of alcohol training.

Acceptable Forms of ID

Driver's License

Military ID

Passport

Government-issued ID

Recommended Age for Carding

30- not mandatory

ID Confiscation

Establishments in Idaho may confiscate false IDs. Contact the Idaho State Liquor Division or local government for the relevant statutes and information.

Policies Regarding Minors

It is unlawful to serve or sell alcohol to anyone under the age of 21. Minors are prohibited from entering and loitering in a bar/lounge area, as defined as a "place". 23-312. PERSONS UNDER TWENTY-ONE AND INTOXICATED PERSONS -- INHIBITED SALES. No officer, agent, or employee of the division shall sell any alcoholic liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one (21) years or to any person intoxicated or apparently intoxicated.

Non-Alcoholic Beer and Wine

Not regulated

Alcohol Liability

Selling or otherwise furnishing alcoholic beverages to an intoxicated person if: the seller or furnisher knew or reasonably should have known that the person was under the legal drinking age or was obviously intoxicated.



Techniques for Effective Alcohol Management

State information: Idaho

The Act requires those bringing suit to put defendant on notice in writing within 180 days after the claim has accrued. IDAHO CODE § 23-808(5).

Generally, the furnishing of alcoholic beverages is not the proximate cause of injuries inflicted by intoxicated persons and it is therefore the intent of the legislature to limit dram shop and social host liability. IDAHO CODE §23-808.
