<u>Server Training</u>

Missouri currently does not regulate server training. However, a licensee can request a session with an enforcement agent to review the laws and information regarding preventing intoxication and recognizing intoxicated patrons.

Policies Regarding Minors

It is unlawful to serve or sell alcohol to anyone under the age of 21.

Alcohol Liability

The possible penalties for violating the Liquor Control Law can range from a written warning to suspension or revocation. There are no monetary fines for violations which occur on retail premises. The decision to dismiss, suspend or revoke a license and for what period of time is at the discretion of The Supervisor of Liquor Control. Effective August 28, 2002, there will be civil penalties possible for violating the Liquor Control Law.
