Server Training

On July 01, 2007 the new law went into effect. This invalidated the local laws covering Alcohol Awareness training in the jurisdictions of Clark County, Las Vegas, North Las Vegas and Mesquite. It states that employees must be certified within 30 days after the date on which they are hired. They may attend a class in person, via the internet or any other electronic means of communication. In addition these cards must be honored in any jurisdiction. This law applies only to a person who sells or serves alcoholic beverages or performs the duties of a security guard.

Recommended Age for Carding

ID Confiscation

Nevada does not prohibit licensees from confiscating false IDs. Licensees may also use a documentary proof of age book.

Policies Regarding Minors

Any person under 21 years of age who purchases, consumes or possesses any alcoholic beverage in any saloon, resort or premises where spirituous, malt or fermented liquors or wines are sold is guilty of a misdemeanor.

Parents, legal guardians or spouses may serve their minor child (spouse) alcohol.

Non-Alcoholic Beer and Wine

Nevada does not regulate non-alcohol beer and wine.

Nevada upholds the common law theory that there is no cause of action against anyone who supplies, furnishes, or sells liquor to another since consumption of liquor is the proximate cause of harm, not the sale or furnishing of alcoholic beverages
