Legal Age to Sell Alcohol: 21
Legal age to Serve Alcohol: 21, 18 in dining areas only
Limit for Driving While Impaired: Driving While Impaired .08
Dram Shop Liability Laws: Yes
Maximum Alcohol per Drink: Not regulated
Number of Drinks Served at One Time: Not Regulated

Server Training

Server training is voluntary by state law, mandatory in some counties.

Acceptable Forms of ID

Valid Driver's License or ID Card
Valid Military ID
Valid Passport
Tribal Cards

Recommended Age for Carding

30 and younger

ID Confiscation

Wyoming does not have any statutes or regulations addressing this subject.

Policies Regarding Minors

It is unlawful to serve or sell alcohol to anyone under the age of 21. An exception to this law is made when a minor is in the physical presence of his parent, spouse or legal guardian who is twenty-one (21) years of age or older.

Liquor Liability

It is unlawful to serve or sell alcohol to anyone under the age of 21. Minors are not permitted to enter or remain in a licensed dispensing room, except in a package liquor store when accompanied by a parent or guardian, and if not prohibited by local ordinance. Minors are allowed in a licensed dispensing room until 10:00 p.m. if accompanied by a parent or guardian if the licensed room includes a waiting or dining area and with the approval of the local licensing authority.
